

MORTIMER 2011 – JOINING INSTRUCTIONS

Saturday 17 September 2011

Mortimer 2011 is being held in the **West Building** at Driffield School, Manorfield Road, DRIFFIELD, East Yorkshire, YO25 5HR. Once on the site follow the signs for “Main Reception”.

Doors will open for registration at 09:30 hrs.

Please make sure you bring your ticket(s) with you to aid registration.

When you register you will get a pack including the detailed programme of speakers. Before the event we will keep our website at <http://mortimer2011.cba-yorkshire.org.uk/> up-to-date with latest news of the programme.

The programme of lectures will start at 10:00hrs. We plan to finish at 17:00 hrs.

There will be a lunch break of between 50-60 minutes. Lunch is **not** included in the ticket price. As the school is a 15 minute walk from the town centre, we recommend that you bring a packed lunch. Tea/coffee will be available at lunchtime.

There will be a tea/coffee break during the morning and a short comfort break during the afternoon.

We have invited ON Books of Sheffield and the Yorkshire Archaeological Society to bring bookstalls and we also hope there will be other displays to peruse during breaks.

In the event of fire or other incident

At the start of the morning session we will point out fire exits and other safety measures. Unless otherwise stated, the fire assembly point will be across the road opposite the main entrance to the West Building. By car

The most convenient route by car from Market Weighton (and the M62) via A163; York via A166; Scarborough via B1249; and, Bridlington via A166, is to approach from the roundabout at the junction of the B1249 Scarborough Road and A614 on the Driffield bypass, travelling towards Driffield on Scarborough Road. Pass over the traffic lights at the junction with Bridlington Road, on to Wansford Road, past the Police Station and turn left into Manorfield Road. At the end of Manorfield Road, just before the entrance barrier at the school entrance, there is a visitors car park on the right. (We also hope to be able to use the Staff car parking on the road opposite the West building).

From Beverley and Hull via A164, follow Beverley Road towards the town centre, bear left on to Middle Street South by the railway station, then turn right into Albion Street. At the top of Albion Street, turn left onto East Gate South, then right onto Harper Street. At Wansford Road turn left, then right into Manorfield Road.

By train or bus

Driffield is on the Hull to Bridlington/Scarborough railway line with a half-hourly service. Hourly through trains originate in Sheffield, passing through Doncaster.

There is also a regular bus service between Hull and Bridlington that stops in Driffield. There is a service from Pocklington that connects with buses to York. We suggest you use <http://www.yorkshiretravel.net/> to find full details of services.

From the railway station, walk past the bus depot, northwest up Middle Street South, then turn right into Albion Street. At the top of Albion Street, turn left onto East Gate South, then right onto Harper Street. At Wansford Road turn left, then right into Manorfield Road.
